

Letter to Club Members and Wildcat Valley Facility Users

Reference: COVID-19/Wildcat Valley Operations

Dear Wildcat Club Users:

Wildcat Valley Rifle and Pistol Club management continues to monitor developments concerning the spread of COVID-19. For now, the Club remains open for member use and has authorized discipline chairs to make the final decision to postpone, cancel, or otherwise restrict scheduled Club activities.

Consistent with additional protocols that may be developed by discipline chairs, the Club highly recommends safety procedures to include the following:

If you have any concern about your health or safety at Wildcat Valley Rifle and Pistol Club, **DON'T COME TO THE CLUB,**

Do not come if you are ill (particularly a cough or fever), have been around anyone who has been or is ill, or if you have a physical condition which may make you more susceptible to illness,

Before coming to the club, use proper sanitation – wash your hands and consider wiping down the gear that you'll be using,

Avoid using the club house, particularly if others are present,

Maintain “social distancing” such as handshakes,

When leaving the club use proper sanitation - hand sanitizer, Clorox or similar wipes,

Be informed about and follow all recommendations of local health departments, CDC, any other entity.

Nothing new here: protect yourself and Club users and consider other Club users as you would expect them to consider your health and safety.
